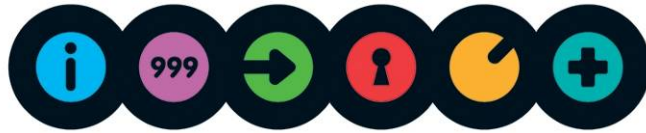

Exercise AMBER LIGHT

Exercise Amber Light is a Civil Contingencies Unit exercise where the CCU Mobile Command Unit is deployed to a Local Authority Rest Centre, Control Room or other pre agreed location to provide support during a hypothetical emergency.



This can be done either as an additional element to your own exercise or as a stand alone event to demonstrate the capability to your nominated emergency management teams.

The mobile command unit and crew can support your organisation in a real emergency

- On the ground as an Office on wheels for Staffordshire's Local Authorities and NHS Trusts.
- Extensive range of communications equipment (voice and data).
- Ability to integrate with emergency services at the scene of an incident



The exercise is aimed at Local Authority and NHS Trusts and consists of the following:

- Half day scenario
- Flexible approach – CCU officers can participate in your exercise in the way that they can during a real incident
- Your organisation's nominees can witness the communications capabilities that would be made available to them during a real emergency
- Scenario tailored to host organisation.
