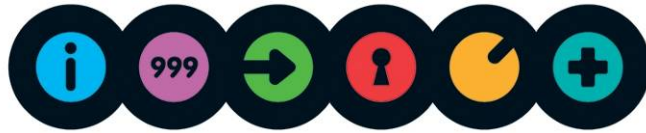

Exercise FOWL PLAY

How would you go about planning to lead a multi agency response operation during a Major Incident?

The Civil Contingencies Unit, on behalf of the Staffordshire Resilience Forum, has developed an exercise, known



as Exercise FOWL PLAY, to help you tackle just this kind of challenge.

Exercise FOWL PLAY is aimed at strategic leaders – Chief Executives and Principal Officers – of Staffordshire's Cat 1 responders. It presents delegates with a complex scenario that is an identified risk on the Staffordshire Community Risk Register.

Key elements of the exercise are as follows:

- Approx two-hour duration
- 1-2-1 'coaching' style of delivery
- Developed with support of the Animal Health Agency and Staffordshire County Council Animal Health
- Provides evidence of CPD

A prerequisite of the course is that delegates must have undertaken Exercise IVOR so that they are familiar with the structure and approach of the exercise.
