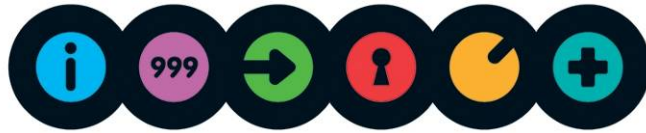

Exercise IVOR

How would you go about planning to lead a multi agency response to a Major Incident?

The Civil Contingencies Unit, on behalf of the Staffordshire Resilience Forum, has developed an exercise, known



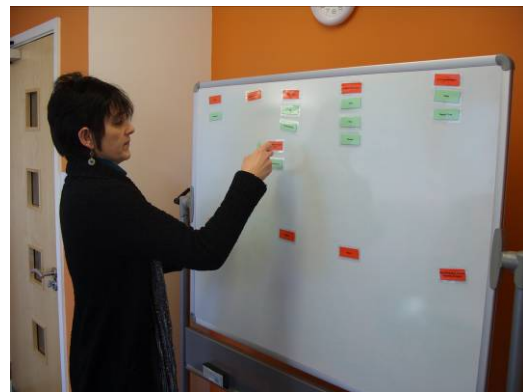
as Exercise IVOR, to help you tackle just this sort of challenge.

Exercise IVOR is aimed at strategic leaders – Chief Executives and Principal Officers – of Staffordshire’s Cat 1 responders. It presents delegates with a complex scenario that is an identified risk on the Staffordshire Community Risk Register.

Key elements of the exercise are as follows:

- Approx two-hour duration
- 1-2-1 ‘coaching’ style of delivery
- Flexible scenario by geographic area
- Provides evidence of CPD

Exercise IVOR is the first in a programme of exercises for strategic leaders and should therefore be undertaken before any further scenarios in the series are tackled.
