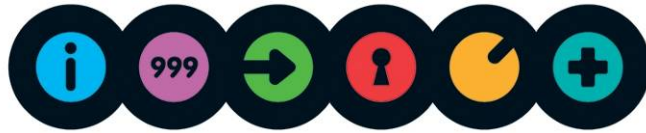

Loggist Training Course

The Civil Contingencies Unit, on behalf of the Staffordshire Resilience Forum has developed a Loggist Training Course.

Trained loggists can provide considerable support to Executive staff within the Strategic and Tactical meeting environment in times of an emergency.

Accurate and timely records of decisions and actions may prove a vital element in protecting lead individuals and organisations with regards to post incident debriefs and any subsequent investigations or enquires.



- Course duration one full day.
- Max of 20 delegates per course.
- Provision of Loggist Handbook.
- Using SRF approved Log Book.
- Held at various locations throughout Staffordshire & Stoke on Trent.

This course is also available to other Local Resilience Forum – POA.



Training will include:

- Understanding of the roles and responsibilities of Category 1 and 2 responders.
- Understanding the environment where a Loggist may be used during the response phase of an emergency.
- Recognition of appropriate information to be recorded and how it should be recorded
- Guidance with regards to the Loggist legal position.
- Recognised methods of Loggist 'best practice'
- Opportunity to practice new skills and methods of logging.
