Multi Agency Mobile Coordination Post (MAMCP)

The Civil Contingencies Unit, on behalf of the Staffordshire Resilience Forum (SRF) has developed the MAMCP concept, the first of its kind in the UK.



The MAMCP deployed with four vehicles linked

The MAMCP is an inflatable structure that links together up to four Mobile Coordination Units via colour-coded 'tunnels'.

Once established, it allows an incident commander and individual service commanders to work jointly with multi agency partners of the SRF, particularly Local Authorities, the NHS and the Environment Agency.

The MAMCP is activated and deployed by Civil Contingencies Unit staff from their base in Stafford and takes approximately one hour to become operational once deployed.

Organisations that can currently link to the MAMCP are Staffordshire Police, Staffordshire Fire & Rescue Service and the Civil Contingencies Unit, with West Midlands Ambulance Service and Staffordshire Search & Rescue Team joining soon.
